CASH MANAGEMENT PLAN OF THE PINE HILL FIRE DISTRICT #1 COUNTY OF CAMDEN NEW JERSEY

I STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

This Cash Management Plan (the 'plan') has been prepared pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:5-14 in order to set forth the basis for deposits ('deposits') and permitted investments ('investments') of certain public funds of the Pine Hill Fire District #1, pending the use of such funds for the intended purposes. The plan is intended to assure that all such public funds are deposited in interest bearing accounts or permitted investments. The intent of the Plan is to provide that the decisions made with regard to the Deposits and the Permitted Investments will be made in a manner intended to insure the safety and preservation of principal value, the liquidity (regarding its availability for the intended purpose) and the maximum investment return within such limits. The plan is intended to insure that any deposit or permitted investment matures within the time period that approximates the prospective need for the funds deposited or invested so that there is not a risk to the market value of such deposits or permitted investments.

II IDENTIFICATION OF FUNDS AND ACCOUNTS TO BE COVERED BY THE PLAN

The Plan is intended to cover the deposit and or investment of the following governmental fund types and accounts of the Pine Hill Fire District #1 as follows:

General Fund
Special Revenue Fund
Debt Service Fund
Capital Projects Fund
General Long-Term Debt Account Group

III DESIGNATION OF OFFICIALS OF THE PINE HILL FIRE DISTRICT #1 AUTHORIZED TO MAKE DEPOSITS AND INVESTMENTS UNDER THE PLAN

The Fire District Administrator of the Pine Hill Fire District #1 shall be charged with the administering of this plan. The Fire District Administrator shall monitor all deposits and investments for consistency with this plan. No person shall engage in an investment transaction involving Pine Hill Fire District #1 funds except as directed or authorized by the Fire District Administrator. Prior to making such deposits or permitted investments, all authorized depositories or investment facilities shall be supplied with a written copy of this plan, which shall be acknowledged in writing by such parties and a copy of such acknowledgement shall be kept on file with the Fire District.

The Fire District Administrator shall be permitted to perform transfers of funds between accounts utilizing the internet services provided by the local bank.

IV DESIGNATION OF DEPOSITORIES

VI AUTHORIZED INVESTMENTS

- A. Except as otherwise specifically provided for herein, the Designated Officials are hereby authorized to invest the public funds covered by this Plan, to the extent not otherwise held in Deposits, in the following Permitted Investments:
 - (1) Bonds or other obligations of the United States of America or obligations guaranteed by the United States of America;
 - (2) Government money market mutual funds;
 - (3) Any obligation that a federal agency or a federal instrumentality has issued in accordance with an act of Congress, which security has a maturity date not greater than 397 days from the date of purchase, provided that such obligation bears a fixed rate of interest not dependent on any index or other external factor;

VI AUTHORIZED INVESTMENTS (CONT'D)

- (4) Bonds or other obligations of the Local Unit or bonds or other obligations of school districts of which the Local Unit is a part or within which the schools district is located;
- (5) Bonds or other obligations, having a maturity date not more than 397 days from the date of purchase, approved by the Division of Investment of the Department of the Treasury for investment by Local Units;
- (6) Local government investment pools;
- (7) Deposits with the State of New Jersey Cash Management Fund established pursuant to section 1 of P.L. 1977, c281 (C.52:18A-90.4) or;
- (8) Agreements for the repurchase of fully collateralized securities if:
 - (a) the underlying securities are permitted investments pursuant to paragraphs (1) and (3) of this subsection a;
 - (b) the custody of collateral is transferred to a third party;
 - (c) the maturity of the agreement is not more than 30 days;
 - (d) the underlying securities are purchased through a public depository as defined in section 1 of P.L. 1970, c.236(C.17:9-41); and
 - (e) a master repurchase agreement providing for the custody and security of collateral is executed

For the purposes of the above language, the term "local government investment pool" shall have the following definitions:

<u>Local Government Investment Pool:</u> An investment pool:

- (a) which is managed in accordance with 17 C.F.R., sec. 270.2a-7:
- (b) which is rated in the highest category by a nationally recognized statistical rating organization;

VI AUTHORIZED INVESTMENTS (CONT'D)

- (c) which is limited to U.S. Government securities that meet the definition of an eligible security pursuant to 17 C.F.R. sec. 270.2a-
- (d) 7 and repurchase agreements that are collateralized by such U.S. Government securities;
- (e) which is in compliance with rules adopted pursuant to the "Administrative" Procedure Act", P.L. 1968, c.410 (c52:14B-1 et seq.) by the Local Finance Board of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs, which rules shall provide for disclosure and reporting requirements, and other provisions deemed necessary by the board to provide for the safety, liquidity and yield of the investments;
- (f) which does not permit investments in instruments that: are subject to high price volatility with changing market conditions; cannot reasonably be expected, at the time of interest rate adjustment, to have a market value that approximates their par value; or utilize an index that does not support a stable net asset value; and
- (g) which purchases and redeems investments directly from the issuer, government money market mutual fund, or the State of New Jersey Cash Management Fund, or through the use of a national or State bank located within this State, or through a broker-dealer which, at the time of purchase or redemption, has been registered continuously for a period of at least two years pursuant to section 9 of P.I. 1967 c.9 (C.49:3-56) and has at least \$25 million in capital stock (or equivalent capitalization if not a corporation), surplus reserves for contingencies and undivided profits, or through a securities dealer who makes primary markets in U.S. Government securities and reports daily to the Federal Reserve Bank of New York its position in and borrowing on such U.S. Government securities.

VII SAFEKEEPING CUSTODY PAYMENT AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RECEIPT OF PLAN

To the extent that any Deposit or Permitted Investment involves a document or security which is not physically held by the Pine Hill Fire District #1, then such instrument or security shall be covered by a custodial agreement with an independent third party, which shall be a bank or financial institution, in the State of New Jersey. Such institution shall provide for the designation of such investments in the name of the Pine Hill Fire District #1 to assure that there is no

unauthorized use of the funds or the Permitted Investments or Deposits. Purchase of any method to ensure that such Permitted Investments are either received by the

Pine Hill Fire District #1 or by a third-party custodian prior to or upon the release of the Pine Hill Fire District #1's funds.

To assure that all parties with whom the Pine Hill Fire District #1 deals either by way of Deposits or Permitted Investments are aware of the authority and the limits set forth in this Plan, all such parties shall be supplied with a copy of this Plan in writing and all such parties shall acknowledge the receipt of that Plan in writing, a copy of which shall be on file with the fire department.

VIII REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Each month during which this Plan is in effect, the Fire District Administrator shall supply to the governing body of the Pine Hill Fire District #1 a written report of any Deposits or Permitted Investments made pursuant to this Plan, which shall include, at a minimum, the following information:

- A. The name of any institution holding funds of the Pine Hill Fire District #1 as a Deposit or a Permitted Investment.
- B. The amount of securities or Deposits purchased or sold during the immediately preceding month.
- C. The class or type of securities purchased, or Deposits made.
- D. The book value of such Deposits or Permitted Investments.
- E. The earned income on such Deposits or Permitted Investments. To the extent that such amounts are actually earned at maturity, this report shall provide an accrual of such earnings during the immediately preceding month.
- F. The fees incurred to undertake such Deposits or Permitted Investments.
- G. The market value of all Deposits or Permitted Investments as of the end of the immediately preceding month.
- H. All other information which may be deemed reasonable from time to time by the governing body of the Pine Hill Fire District #1.

IX TERM OF PLAN

This Plan shall be in effect from the date of this resolution to December 31, 2024. Attached to this Plan is a Resolution of the governing body of the Pine Hill Fire District #1 approving this Plan for such period of time. This Plan may be amended from time to time. To the extent that any amendment is adopted by the Commissioners, the Designated Officials are directed to supply copies of the amendments to all of the parties who otherwise have received the copy of the originally approved Plan, which amendment shall be acknowledged in writing in the same manner as the original Plan was so acknowledged.

ESTABLISHING RULES OF ORDER AND CONDUCT FOR ALL REGULAR, WORK SESSION AND SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, The Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District #1 of the Borough of Pine Hill desires to establish standard rules of order and regulations for public participation at Fire Commission meetings for the purpose of promoting efficiency and a fair opportunity for public comment on issues and concerns when meetings are open to the public, and to assure that the business of the Fire Commission can be conducted within a reasonable time, and

WHEREAS, in order to assure that appropriate decorum is maintained during meetings when a member of the public comments to the Board of Fire Commissioners, it is necessary to establish reasonable guidelines.

NOW THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Borough of Pine Hill as follows:

- a) The Board of Fire Commissioners hereby sets a reasonable time limitation for each speaker when any portion of the meeting is open for public participation. Each speaker shall be limited to five (5) minutes per speaker with a limit of two speaking opportunities. The two (2) per person speaking opportunity shall not be consecutive so as to allow other members of the public to make an appropriate speaking opportunity presentation to the Board. When each person who desires to speak at the public meeting has had an opportunity to address the Board, a person may be recognized for a second speaking opportunity. The second speaking opportunity is also limited to five minutes. The practice of yielding time to or borrowing time from others is not permitted.
- b) Foul, vulgar or course language shall not be tolerated.

- c) At the discretion of Chairman of the Board of Fire Commissioners, with the consent of the majority of Board members present, on issues being presented, this time limitation may be relaxed or extended from time to time and such extension, relaxation or suspension of time limitation shall not constitute a binding precedent for other speakers on other issues.
- d) Large groups on single issues are urged to select a spokesperson to present their concerns.
- e) Any desired question to specific members of the Board shall be directed to the Board Chairman for recognition of specific Board members. The intent is to avoid a "back and forth" exchange. Board Members may or may not respond to any public presentment after there has been a completion of the public speaker's presentment.

Chief's Monthly Report

November 2023

Meetings:

- On Thursday the 2nd, I attended the commission meeting.
- On Thursday evening the 16th, I attended the swearing in for Deputy Chief Derek Kramer from the Erial Fire Department.
- On Tuesday evening the 21st, I attended the fire company meeting.
- On Tuesday evening the 21st, I held an officers' meeting to discuss what I expect of them next year.
- On Wednesday morning the 22nd, I held a staff meeting to hand out next year's responsibilities.

Calls for Service / Significant Concerns:

- On Wednesday morning the 1st, we were special called to 3 Laurel Hill Court in Berlin Borough for a working house fire. Battalion Chief Pizzo and I responded along with Engine 6 and the Engine was second due. The Engine laid a 5" supply line from Quint 211 to the hydrant and supplied them with water. The balance of the crew along with Battalion Chief Pizzo, stretched a second line and assisted with extinguishment of a kitchen fire. Upon my arrival I was ordered to the rear (division C) as the division commander.
- On Thursday afternoon the 2nd, Tower Ladder 6 was dispatched to 77 Roseland Circle in Winslow for a dwelling fire. Battalion Chief Pizzo and Tower Ladder 6 were both second due. Chief 85 had smoke showing and ordered Tower Ladder 6 to complete a primary search. Battalion Chief Pizzo was ordered to division "C" as the commander. It was found to be a heater fire in the basement that was extinguished by the crew on Quint 85. Tower Ladder 6 ventilated the basement before going available.
- On Thursday evening the 2nd, we were dispatched to 165 Kearsley Road in Erial for a dwelling fire. Battalion Chief Pizzo along with Engine 6 responded and the Engine was first due. Chief 86 on location and reporting a garage fire 50' x 50' well involved asking for the all-hands box. Engine 6 laid a 5" supply line from the beginning of the dirt driveway and attacked the fire with their deck gun and a 2 ½ hand line. The crew operated well into the morning.
- On Sunday morning the 12th, we were dispatched to 32 Kirk Lane in Pine Hill for a dwelling fire. Engine 6 responded with a crew of 4 and were on location in 4 minutes

and 30 seconds after dispatch. Tower Ladder 6 responded with a crew of 4 also. A column from the fire could be seen from the firehouse. Engine 6 arrived on location and PHPD advised Captain Crosby that there were two people trapped. The order was given by Captain Crosby to Tower Ladder 6 to perform a primary search upon their arrival. The crew from Engine 6 stretched a 1 ¾ hand line through the front door and tried to make the second floor. They were pushed back due to fire conditions and one member of the crew's foot falling through the steps. They held their position at the base of the stairs to hold the fire back. The Tower Ladder crew arrived and started the primary search. With permission from the Tower Ladder Officer, Firefighter Koch searched ahead of the crew. Firefighter Koch found a confused female just off the kitchen and removed her from the dwelling, handed her off to PHPD Officer. While the rescue was being made the female advised Firefighter Koch that the other trapped victim was in the basement. That information was passed on to the Tower Ladder officer Weidner and they headed to the basement for the search. Lt. Torres and Firefighter Duvall arrived and reported to the command post. They were ordered by me to stretch a second hand line and protect the exposure on the "D" side of the house. As they approached the Engine to stretch the second line, they were ordered by Chief Dimitri to enter the dwelling and search for the second victim that was now reported to be on the first floor in the rear. After searching the rear and not finding the victim, they moved to the front of the house for a secondary search. Lt. Torres searched the bathroom and found an unconscious male on the floor. Lt. Torres and Firefighter Duvall carried the victim to the "B" side of the house. The victim was handed off to Chief Dimitri and carried to the front of the house, with help from Firefighter Duvall. It must be noted that the first rescue was made 9 minutes after dispatch, second rescue made 12 minutes after dispatch, and the emergency evacuation was transmitted at 14 minutes after dispatch.

- On Friday afternoon the 17th, we were special called for a motor vehicle accident rescue assignment on Watsontown New Freedom Road in Berlin. Battalion Chief Pizzo and I responded with Squad 6. We arrived to find one vehicle on fire and the other vehicle split in half. All victims were out of the vehicles prior to our arrival. Squad 6 assisted Berlin with extinguishment of the vehicle fire.
- On Tuesday afternoon the 21st, Battalion Chief Pizzo along with Tower Ladder 6
 responded to 7 Clements Hand Court in Winslow for a reported dwelling fire. Chief 86
 arrived first and reported smoke from the rear yard. It was determined to be patio
 furniture and fencing on fire. Tower Ladder 6 was sent to the interior to check for fire
 extension. The Tower Ladder's crew assisted with overhaul before being released.
- On Tuesday afternoon the 28th, we were dispatched to 21 Brookshire Road in Erial for a
 dwelling fire. Battalion Chief Pizzo and I, along with Engine 6 responded. Chief 85 on
 location reporting smoke showing and requesting the all-hands box to be transmitted.
 Battalion Chief Pizzo arrived and was ordered to the "C" side as the commander. I
 arrived and was given the operations role. Engine 85 stretched a 1 ¾ hand line through

the front door. Engine 6 was ordered to take the hydrant and the manpower to stretch and second hand line off Quint 85 and stretch it to the second floor on the "B" 1 exposure. Squad 88 arrived and ordered to stretch a 1 ¾ hand line off their truck and stretch it to the second floor on the "D" 1 exposure, after they forced the door. A second alarm was transmitted for manpower. Tower Ladder 6 arrived and assisted with overhaul. Squad 25 crew stretched a fourth 1 ¾ hand line to back up the first line.

Public relations:

- We installed 3 smoke detectors at 400 Turnersville Road.
- We installed one CO detector at 165 Hidden Drive (Erial).
- Replaced 5 batteries at 12 Lincoln Lane.
- Installed one CO detector at 106 Monticello Drive (Erial).
- Installed one smoke detector at 2905 Tall Pines.
- On Thursday afternoon the 16th, we provided the Tower Ladder to Public Works and assisted with installing the star on the tree at Veterans Park.
- On Saturday afternoon the 11th, we attended the Veterans Service.

Tower Ladder:

 On Wednesday the 1st we had the annual pump test completed. Unfortunately, the truck failed because it could not hold a draft. We are working to make the repair.

Squad:

• On Wednesday the 1st we had the annual pump test competed. Unfortunately, the truck failed because the primer was not working. We are working to make the repair.

Grant:

- I am still waiting to hear the results for the two (AFG). We have not received any turn down letters, so I am still hopeful.
- I did receive a turn down letter from the Leary Foundation (thermal imagining cameras).
- Still waiting on the Gary Sinise Grant.

• On Saturday morning the 18th, I attended the monthly training at the high school.

- We are starting to bring in some money from motor vehicle accidents.
- We sent 7 more motor vehicles accidents this month for billing.

 On Wednesday the 15th, the ambulance was taken to Burlington County for a State Inspection. The unit did pass the inspection and meets all the requirements for 2024.

Swearing In:

• I would like to hold the January 4th meeting at the borough hall. I feel that the swearing in for Captain Duvall will be well attended.
