It also does not include some typical information you see in your usage details, such as the time stamp of calls or texts.

Protecting customer data is a top priority. We have confirmed the affected system has been secured. We are constantly evaluating and enhancing our security protections to address the evolving cybersecurity threat landscape.

#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE SURVEY:**

- 1. Discuss Current Loss Control Concerns for Fire Districts.
- 2. New and Outstanding Suggestions for Improvement.

#### SURVEY RESULTS:

#### OBJECTIVE #1: Discuss Current Loss Control Concerns for Fire Districts.

I met representatives of the Fire District at the fire station on Erial Road. No significant new risk control exposures were reported or anticipated by the District.

The District had two burn injuries to firefighters' ears in 2024. We discussed the circumstances of each and the results of the District's reviews. We also discussed the medical evaluations and conditions for restricted duty defined in NFPA Standard 1582 for comprehensive occupational medical programs for fire departments.

NJPEOSH identified fire departments as a focus for inspections. The District recently completed a voluntary inspection by PEOSH. We discussed common issues found by inspectors.

We discussed two employment risk control strategies:

- The Fire District does not check motor vehicle records annually. I explained the exposure this creates for the District. I encourage them to contact the Fund Administrator to begin this process.
- I reminded the representatives of the Fund's EPL Hotline. Contact the Fund Administrator for more information.

This report does not and is not intended to address every loss potential, but covers only those conditions specifically examined at time of the survey. There may be other conditions not examined or brought to our attention at the time of this survey, that may contain a potential for liability. This report does not include matters of a legal nature or violations of any federal, state or local statute, ordinance or regulation, except as specifically noted in the report.

We discussed rising property claims arising from fire agencies:

- 1. There is an increase in the cost and frequency of property claims. The backing of apparatus is one significant cause.
  - a. The aprons of the station are lined. Bollards are not present.
  - b. The District has a policy that requires spotters when backing apparatus.
- 2. Claims are also rising from damage to stations and apparatus from inclement weather. We discussed actions that could be taken to combat these claims.
  - a. Have a periodic station inspection process that stresses 1) common causes of firefighter injuries, such as slips and trips, and 2) causes of damage to stations, such as clogged gutters.
  - b. Institute a formal process for preparing stations and apparatus ahead of forecasted storms, such as hurricanes or snowstorms.
  - c. Train drivers on policies for driving through flood waters.
- 3. The third area is an increase in the cost and frequency of property claims arising from damage to apparatus crashes, especially during response. We discussed some elements of a <u>comprehensive policy</u>.
  - a. Including definitions of True Emergency and Due Diligence in the policy and daily conversations between officers and drivers on applying these principles after responses.
  - b. Initial and periodic refresher qualification of driving skills
  - c. Initial and periodic physical examinations of drivers, ideally based on the industry standard, NFPA Standard 1582.
  - d. Lights & sirens, intersection control, and other driving protocols

#### Chief's Monthly Report

July 2024

#### Meetings:

- I did not attend the commission meeting or the fire company meeting (was on vacation).
- The Camden Country Fire Chiefs are on summer break.

#### **Calls for Service / Significant Concerns:**

- On Wednesday evening the 3<sup>rd</sup>, tower ladder 6 was dispatched to 32 North Black Horse Pike in Blackwood for a building fire. Battalion 6 responded with the tower ladder, and he assisted in the command role. The crew from the tower ladder searched and forced doors.
- On Tuesday evening the 16<sup>th</sup>, the squad was dispatched to the working fire box at 122 Washington Ave in Berlin Borough for a house that was struck by lightning. The squad responded with a crew of 4 and assisted with overhaul. Battalion 6 responded and was assigned the accountability officer. I went to our firehouse and covered the area with a crew of 6 from our building.
- On the evening of the 19<sup>th</sup>, tower ladder 6 was dispatched to 501 Reading Ave in Winslow Township for a working house fire. The ladder crew assisted with extinguishment of the fire.
- On Monday night the 22<sup>nd</sup>, tower ladder 6 along with the battalion and I responded to Vance Drive in Lambs Terrace for a reported house fire. Battalion 6 was the operations officer and the crew from the tower ladder assisted with ventilation. It was found to be a small fire in the basement.
- On Tuesday evening the 30<sup>th</sup>, task force 6 was dispatched to the Greens of Pine Hill, 350 Blackwood Clementon Road for an apartment fire. Battalion 6 arrived first and reported the fire to be extinguished. The crew from engine 6 confirmed that the fire was extinguished but had extended to the cabinet. The crew from tower ladder 6 ventilated the apartment and checked the apartment above for fire extension.
- On Tuesday evening the 30<sup>th</sup>, we were dispatched to Millbridge Apartments on Blackwood Clementon Road for an apartment fire with reported people trapped.
   Tower ladder 6 responded with a crew of 5 and completed a primary search upon

their arrival. Battalion 6 responded and assisted in the command roll. I responded to our firehouse to cover the area and had a crew of 4 in our building.

- On Wednesday evening the 3<sup>rd</sup>, we participated in the Borough Fireworks.
- On Thursday evening the 4th, we participated in the Fireworks at Trump.
- On Sunday morning the 20<sup>th</sup>, I participated in the Ben-To-Shore bike ride (using our BLS unit).
- On Wednesday morning the 31<sup>st</sup>, we sent the engine to the Bean School for a wetdown.

#### **Grants:**

• On Wednesday the 24<sup>th</sup>, I submitted paperwork for the American Water Grant, looking for just under \$2,100.00 for two Thermal Imaging Cameras.

#### **Training:**

• On Monday evening the 29<sup>th</sup>, I attended the fire company monthly training (sprinkler systems).

#### **Tower Ladder:**

• Pm is completed, air conditioner repaired, and 4 rear tires replaced.

#### **Company Event:**

• We had a great turnout for the company picnic at Trump. We were also able to invite the family of Josua McAllester, who was the young boy that knocked on the door of 1033 Turnersville Road advising the resident that his house was on fire.

#### Vacation:

I was on vacation from the 8<sup>th</sup> to the 12<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Bariatric:**

• I was approached by Jason Higgins from the Camden County OEM, inquiring if we would be interested in making our ambulance into a bariatric unit. All the equipment has been purchased and the installation of that equipment has been paid for. If interested, we would work out the details with the County OEM.

#### **Turnout Gear:**

Berlin Fire Company donated 14 sets of turnout gear that they no longer use. Most of
the gear is at the ten-year mark but is still in great condition. We have accepted new
